

HENRY A. HECK

Funeral services for Henry A. Heck, 76, who died unexpectedly Friday at his home at Eastport, were held Monday at St. Mary's church. The Rev. R. Dale Magoon officiated. Interment was in Lakeview Cemetery, Torch Lake township, Antrim County. The Rosary was recited at the Winchester Funeral Home Sunday evening.
